One evening, a young woman saunters in and, between mouthfuls of chips, invites him to visit her in the World of Ideas. Ben is excited, but suspicious. The World of Ideas is the philosopher's quarter of the afterlife, and adorable Lila has been residing there for thirty

years, but being dead is just the start of her problems. Charming and full of wit and humor, Lucy Eyre's *If Minds Had Toes* warmly shows that few other questions-how we live and whether our lives have meaning-are more important.

Ben Warner is dizzy with boredom, working for the summer in Cod Almighty, his local fish and chip shop, when one evening a sexy young woman called Lila arrives with a bizarre invitation. Ben is tempted, but suspicious - and with good reason. Lila wants him to visit her in the World of Ideas - a place he's never heard of - and, though Ben doesn't yet know it, Lila has been dead for thirty years (which at least explains the purple flares). Little by little, Ben starts to ask his own questions and to believe that - apart from football - the unexamined life is not really worth living.
